Dear Potential Volunteer,

On behalf of the Makah Tribal Council and the Tribal Journeys 2010 Executive Committee, I am pleased to announce that the Makah Tribe will host the 2010 Tribal Journeys in Makah Territory at Neah Bay, WA. We have scheduled the final landing date for Monday, July 19, and plan to conclude the celebration on Saturday, July 24.

The amount of people attending is estimated at 10-15,000, which is about 5-7 times the population of Neah Bay. To adequately meet the needs of this many people, we are seeking volunteers to assist us with several aspects of Tribal Journeys. A sign-up sheet with a list of duties you could specifically volunteer to do is included in this packet.

Camping areas will be available for volunteers at the Makah Cultural & Resource Center. This area will have shower and a laundry facility, as well as shuttle services to the main event and the vendor area. We strongly encourage you to utilize the shuttle services, as parking will be very limited. Beginning Monday, July 19<sup>th</sup>, we will serve dinner each night and starting on Tuesday, July 20<sup>th</sup>, continental breakfast items will be available as well.
